**Order of the Administrative Director of the Division of Workers' Compensation  
Official Medical Fee Schedule – Ambulance Fee Schedule  
Inflation Factor Effective for Services Rendered on or after September 8, 2005**

Pursuant to Labor Code section 5307.1(g), the Administrative Director of the Division of Workers' Compensation orders that Title 8, California Code of Regulations, section 9789.70, pertaining to Ambulance Services in the Official Medical Fee Schedule, is adjusted to conform to the January 1, 2005 change to the Medicare payment system.

Medicare Data Source and Incorporation by Reference

The Medicare CY05 Ambulance Inflation Factor was published on November 15, 2004 in the Federal Register (Vol. 69 FR 66918) and is entitled "Medicare Program; Coverage and Payment of Ambulance Service; Recalibration of Conversion Factor; Inflation Update for CY 2005" (CMS-1267-N). The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services determined that the Ambulance Inflation Factor for Calendar Year 2005 is 3.3%. This figure is equal to the percentage increase in the consumer price index for all urban consumers for the 12-month period ending with June 2004, as required by the Medicare statute.

Application of Ambulance Inflation Factor to OMFS

The Ambulance Inflation Factor is to be applied to fees for services rendered on or after September 8, 2005, by multiplying the ambulance service fee by 1.033%.
